Arranging your Child's Baptism

We are happy to welcome the newest members of our parish, their parents and families. Please call the parish office so that we can help you (631-929-4339), or email us at office@sjbwr.org.

1. Setting the Baptism Date: Usually we meet together to gather the information about your child, and help you select a date for Baptism. Baptisms are scheduled monthly on the first Sunday throughout the year. They are also scheduled on the third Sunday of the month, but please check for the dates by contacting the Parish Office.
2. Time: Baptisms are celebrated at 12:00 p.m. .
3. Baptism Class: The Church prepares the parents before the baptism so that they can be guided on how to raise their child in the Catholic Faith. You can attend the Baptism Preparation Session on the last Sunday of the month right after the 10:30 Mass.
4. "Naming Mass": Our parish community also looks forward to praying with you before the baptism of your child at any one of our weekend Masses. The new parents and the child, with your family, have special seating in our church, and after the homily we welcome your child with a blessing and promise the prayers and support of our parish community.
5. Donation to the Parish: Please use the baptism donation envelope for your donation to the parish. You can drop it off in the parish office before the baptism, or bring it with you to the ceremony.
6. Other Questions: We will be happy to also help you with these and other questions:
 - Can we help register you as a new family in our parish?
 - Can we help you discern your choice of godmother and/or godfather?
 - Do you have any questions about your marriage, so perhaps we can arrange for you to have your marriage blessed in the Catholic Church?
