Strengthening our Confirmation Preparation Program Moving Confirmation to Fall of 9th Grade

We prepare our young people to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation over a two-year period. Typically, in the past here at St. John the Baptist, those who begin their two-year Confirmation Preparation are in the 7th Grade and continue through the 8th grade, received the Sacrament of Confirmation in the spring of 8th Grade.

In order to strengthen our program and connect our young people with our parish ministries, Confirmation will be celebrated in the fall of the 9th grade. Our current Grade 8 students are in their second year of preparation; they will complete two full years of preparation from 2020-2022 and participate in the Confirmation retreat and celebrate Confirmation in the fall of 2022.
