



100th Anniversary “Logo”

The Pastoral Council discussed the 100th anniversary from 2018 until the “shutdown” in March of 2020. The Council wanted a “logo” that would capture the main ideas of our parish 100th anniversary.

The stained glass window in the sanctuary is the central focus of the logo. This remind us of the Sunday Eucharist as the source and summit of our parish life, and St. John the Baptist who is our patron saint. The stained glass window is also used on the parish signage throughout the church plant.

The parish was founded in 1922 (it was a mission of Sts. Peter and Paul since 1912).

Celebrate – Renew – Inspire are three aspects of our year-long marking of the 100th anniversary. These include

Celebrate:

- Jubilee Mass: with Bishop Barres (probably the end of June, 2022)
- Parish Barbecue: no date is set yet, but the Council would like to connect it to the anniversary Mass with the bishop.
- Event for younger families and children to mark the anniversary.

Renew:

- Education about our patron saint: Fr. Frank Schneider will present a year-long bulletin series about St. John the Baptist, especially in Sacred Scripture, tradition and art. We are invited to pray to St. John for our parish.
- Holyland Pilgrimage: March 28-April 7, “In the Footsteps of Jesus and John the Baptist,” including Jordan and Israel. Father Frank will lead the group.
- Parish Lenten Mission with Msgr. Vlaun and group of diocesan priests, Lent of 2022.
- Jubilee Healing and Forgiveness: Healing Mass to be scheduled in 2022.

Inspire:

- Centennial Journal to include our history, photos, stories from parishioners.
- Jubilee Service to the Poor Parish Project
- Presentation through music and images
